# Minister's Message:

Let me share with you one of this week's lectionary lessons, Matthew 5:38-42, the words from the Message version of the scripture. They suggest to us: "Here is another old saying that deserves a second look: "Eye for eye, tooth for tooth." Is that going to get us anywhere? Here is what I propose: "Don't hit back at all." If someone strikes you, stand there and take it. If someone drags you into court and sues for the shirt off your back, giftwrap your best coat and make a present of it. And if someone takes unfair advantage of you, use the occasion to practice the servant life. No more tit-for-tat stuff. Give generously."

Giftwrap your best coat. Make a present of it. Live generously. The Gospel writer Matthew is challenging us to live out our God-created identity. This week we will study three different scriptures that have something important to say to us about our styles of living. One of those scriptures is the Matthew lesson, another will be taken from the Old Testament book of Leviticus, 19:1-9. The final scripture for study will be I Corinthians 3:10-11; 16-23. We will be thinking about the issue of how as Christians we might make more significant contributions of civility in the world in which we live. After all the community of God should reflect the character of God. As stated in I Peter 2:9 "It shows forth the praises of him who called you." The people of God should be spreading all sorts of positive virtues that build a healthy community. Sunday's sermon will be entitled, "I Have Two Cheeks."
