Minister's Message:

There is an old logic puzzle that I believe I have shared with you before. You are carrying a hen, some corn, and a fox, and you need to cross the river. But your boat can only handle you and one other thing. If you leave the fox on the bank with the hen, that will not be good. If you leave the hen with the corn, the hen will consume the corn. You are supposed to bring the hen across first, then come back and take the fox over, and bring the hen back with you to where you started your journey. Then bring the corn, so that fox and corn are at the second destination, and then go back and get the hen. I recently heard of another solution, far less tricky. First, you bring the hen across. Then, you go back and get the corn. Finally, leave the fox there. What were you doing with a fox?

That will be the question we will be asking this Sunday morning "What are we doing with the fox?" It will be a time to study the life of Jesus as he prepares to go into the city of Jerusalem. The Pharisees are trying to warn him that Herod is going to attempt to take his life. Jesus is extremely strong in his response, "Tell that fox that I am casting out demons and performing cures today and tomorrow, I am going to finish my work, I have a mission to fulfill." It was during the famous "Battle of the Bulge," in World War II, U.S. troops became surrounded near the town of Bastogne, in France. The German commander sent the troops a message, reminding them of their situation and demanded their unconditional surrender. General McAulife, the army general in charge of our forces sent a one word reply, "nuts!" I think that was the spirit of the reply of Jesus to Herod. You and I live in a world that tempts us to give in to our fears. But the season of Lent is a time to strengthen our faith and to encounter those fears with the assistance of our God. Be with us this Sunday as our sermon will be entitled, "Listening to the Fox." The scripture for your study will be Luke 13:31-35.
