

Minister's Message:

I must admit that last Sunday morning without you was a strange, strange feeling. I believe that in all thirty-seven years of ministry, we have only cancelled our worship service once. None of us can forget that occasion, the Sunday of the 1997 flood. Hopefully this weekend you will be able to be present for the second Sunday of our Lenten season. Our decision made regarding last week's worship was one that much time and thought went into making. Our main concern was for your safety. Thanks to our staff and many members who assisted with spreading the word. The forty days of Lent are intended to be used for our spiritual reflection. Please pick up your Lenten devotional books compiled by our Worship department to be used during this season. You can pick them up Sunday in the fellowship hall. Our sermon on Sunday will contain some thoughts from last week's sermon, plus some new ideas from a new scripture. Part of last week's sermon that I shared at Cedar Ridge on Sunday afternoon, I share with you now. During Lent, we are challenged to not only give up some parts of life, but to say yes to other parts of life and disciplines. I handed out a list to the residents that asked us to pray for certain people and drop them a note during these forty days of Lent. That list included, someone in need of healing, a person you have not seen in at least a year, someone who inspires you, someone who once forgave you. Send a note to someone who is lonely, is mourning, you are proud of, someone who walked with you through the valley of the shadow of death. Write someone who could blackmail you but chooses not to, someone you once got in trouble with, a mother figure, a father figure. Remember those close to you as family and as a family of friends. Share your concern with someone you have known as long as you can remember, or someone who knows the nickname you are always trying to forget. Tell people you are just thinking of them and have offered a special prayer for them. I hope that you and I get off to a great start with our Lenten disciplines. We'll talk about them on Sunday. Will be good to see you. Be safe.
