Minister's Message:

I fondly remember a trip that Anna and I once took to San Francisco, California. I remember that we stayed at a hotel named Sir Frances Drake Hotel. I never knew until this week what Drake had to do with California history. On December 13, 1577, Drake set out from England with five ships on a mission to raid Spanish holdings on the Pacific Coast of the New World. During his circumnavigation of the world, Sir Francis claims the territory for Queen Elizabeth I. In 1581, Queen Elizabeth I knighted Drake for his exploits.

This Sunday our sermon title will be, "The Prayer of Desmond Tutu." Actually the prayer may have been one brought to life by Sir Frances Drake. We will examine that prayer this Sunday morning and see what it says to us. The background for our study will be Matthew 17: 1-9, the Mount of Transfiguration. Speaking of discoveries as made by Sir Frances Drake with the territory of California, let me share with you a discovery someone in the church made this week. We think we may be bringing our best, but it may be keys, screws, and our tokens from Monkey Joes. I am surprised we didn't have some tokens from one of my favorite places, Chuck E. Cheese's.
