# Minister's Message:

This Sunday morning we will focus our attention on the prayer of Dietrich Bonhoeffer. Bonhoeffer was a German Lutheran pastor, theologian, and a participant in the German resistance movement against Nazism. For his activities he was arrested in April, 1943 and executed by hanging in April 1945. His death came 23 days before the Nazis' surrender. Bonhoeffer was one of the twentieth-century's most brilliant minds. He was a person who anchored his daily life in the disciplines of the bible and the importance of prayer. He also was an excellent author, a skilled musician, a lover of literature, a very energetic friend, and a Christian martyr. We will share additional facts regarding this person on Sunday morning as we worship together on this fourth Sunday of Lent. I take this time to share some quotes for you from this pastor. I believe they provide for you some insight into his thinking:

- "We must learn to regard people less in the light of what they do or omit to do, and more in the light of what they suffer"
- "We are not to simply bandage the wounds of victims beneath the wheels of injustice, we are to drive a spoke into the wheel itself."
- "The ultimate test of a moral society is the kind of world it leaves to its children."
- "We pray for the big things and forget to give thanks for the ordinary, small gifts,"
- "By judging others we blind ourselves to our own evil and to the grace which others are just as entitled to as we are."

Bonhoeffer's prayer we will share Sunday has to do with the subject of fear and our need to have Christ beside of us. You and I need to hear that same message. How many times do we announce in a moment of sincerity, "I cannot do this alone?" Good news, we don't have to. He is there with us in our pain and suffering, our anxiety and grief, our questioning and doubts, in both joys and sorrows. See you Sunday.
