

## **Return to Church Frequently Asked Questions**

There are now two church services! Can I choose which service I attend? *Yes you can. There are two church services to allow for adequate social distancing of six feet. There is no age restriction on attending either service.*

Do I have to wear a mask? *Yes. This is a requirement for attendance at church services for anyone over the age of 2. Exception will be made only for those who are physically incapable of wearing a mask.*

If I have been vaccinated do I still need to wear a mask? *Yes. At this time we ask that all who attend church continue to wear a mask. We expect that some attendees will not have had a chance to be vaccinated when we return to worship.*

Are masks available at church? *Yes.*

I have a medical condition that prevents me from wearing a mask, but I have been vaccinated. What about me? *If you are unable to wear a mask and have been vaccinated we suggest speaking with your physician to discuss the risks and benefits in these and other similar situations.*

Should I check my temperature before I come to church? *You are not required to check your temperature before attending church. Temperatures WILL NOT be checked upon arrival at church. If you are ill, or even suspect you might be “coming down with something,” stay home.*

I woke up with a cough this morning but am pretty sure it is just allergies. Can I still come to church? *At this time if you have any symptoms that may suggest a possible illness we ask that you worship from home.*

How do I worship from home? *Video of the service is on YouTube and Facebook. Audio of the service is available on the church website. You may also tune in to WCYN radio, 1400 AM and 101.3 FM. Sunday mornings at 9:30 A.M.*

**Minister's Message:**

As a sophomore I decided to transfer colleges, attending Lynchburg College. I remember as if it were yesterday. I was pulling out of the driveway in my 1964 Chevrolet Malibu and my mom ran out with a gift she had forgotten to share with me. It was a book entitled, A Man Called Peter, featuring the sermons of Peter Marshall. Marshall was the Senate chaplain from January 4, 1947 until his sudden death of a heart attack on January 26, 1949. I became a fan of his sermons and even more so his prayers. Easter never passes that I do not read his prayers related to this occasion. I share my favorite prayer of his written Thursday, March 25, 1948:

“Lord Jesus, Saviour of the world, in Thy holy name we join our hearts in prayer. This week, as we remember all thou didst endure for us, we may be sure thou hast not forgotten. For we will not let thee forget. With every sin of ours, we renew the pain Thy heart did know. Every time we ignore Thee, forget Thee, and heed not Thy way, we revive for Thee the loneliness Thou didst feel and the spiritual blindness that broke Thy heart. O Lord, give us Thy grace that we may not crucify Thee afresh, but loving Thee keep Thy commandments. With a steady faith that Thy kingdom will yet be established upon the earth, help us to hasten its coming by letting Thee work in us and through us to do Thy will. Amen.”

I believe this is a very fitting prayer for all of us to pray at the beginning of Holy week. Please remember to stop by the church on Saturday to pick up your Lenten devotionals. A note of thanks to the church staff, the Worship Committee and to the authors for making these very inspirational books available for you.
