Minister's Message:

I am in my office thinking about what to include in a funeral eulogy for a lady that over the years taught me much. After all, I spent some twenty-eight years with this person, which is only about half of the years she gave to this church. Of course, I am speaking about Madelyn Adams, who passed away this week and whose funeral will be at the church on Friday. Madelyn recently celebrated her 100th birthday, but today is a different sort of celebration. Our Christian faith reminds us that death is not the end, but only a new beginning. I will always appreciate Madelyn's love for her church and for her family. I will also remember how she assisted a young thirty-one year old minister with his first full-time pastorate. The Cynthiana Christian Church received much from this servant and her husband Clay and should always be indebted from their gifts shared. How she loved this church. But more importantly how she loved her children, grandchildren, great grandchildren, nieces and nephews. Whatever they were doing in their individual pursuits, she was there. Driving many miles to watch one of their activities was looked upon as a pleasure by Madelyn. I was looking over the attendance pads this morning and viewed one with an additional comment. I am appreciative to one of you for the message, I needed it this morning. The note quoted the poet Tennyson, "He who braves youths' dizzy heat, dreads not the frost of age." For our loved ones, death is not something to be dreaded, but celebrated. I hope to see you Sunday morning as our sermon topic will be entitled, "Knock on Any Door." Thank goodness death is not an experience that locks us in. We are after all, resurrection people.
