The history of the lighthouse is an interesting one. The first lighthouse was built in 283 B.C., the lighthouse of Alexandria. It was thought of as one of the seven wonders of the ancient world. The keepers of the lighthouse thought of their position as a calling, not a job. It was not a job for the faint of heart. Lighthouse keepers had to be prepared for adverse conditions, sea rescues.
