

Minister's Message:

What pleasant memories our youth shared with us on Sunday morning. They were both insightful and inspirational. Most all of us have memories of church as youngsters. The Rev. Sharon Blezard has an interesting one, really it was an after-church memory. As Sharon climbed into the backseat of the family's VW Bug after church her mother stated to her, "Don't eat your candy until we get home." She reflected that she had earned it by knowing a memory Bible verse, and here is her mother being a spoilsport. Besides it was a twenty minute drive home. Not fair. What five-year old can resist a colorful roll of life savers? She recalls opening the pack and placing several life savers in her mouth, they were delicious. Sharon was taken back when her father hit a large bump in the road. The forbidden treat was stuck in her throat. Unable to swallow or breathe, her mother turned around and viewed her growing alarm, along with the roll of opened life savers. She yelled, "Stop the car George, now George." She was out of the door before the bug came to a stop, dragged her daughter from the seat, thumping her soundly on her back. Blezard relays, "Between the thumping and my coughing, the "evidence" quickly came forth onto the asphalt."

This Sunday we will talk about Paul's message to the church at Rome, Romans 7:15-25a. Paul is speaking to us about the struggle he faces. As Eugene Peterson translates Paul in The Message, "He (Jesus) acted to set things right in this life of contradictions where I want to serve God with all my heart and mind, but am pulled by the influence of sin to do something totally different."
