Green Chalice News You Can Use: Try some of these strategies for cutting costs and energy consumption with your air conditioning system. Keep the filter clean. Dirty filters limit airflow and make the unit run longer. Clean or replace the filter every month or so during the summer. Make sure your air conditioner is in good working order. Air conditioners require professional maintenance to keep them working effectively. Set your thermostat higher and still stay comfortable by using a floor or tabletop fan in addition to the AC. Shade your air conditioner. Don’t locate central air conditioners in direct sunlight. Place window units on the north side of your house, which remains more shaded. A shaded air conditioner uses up to 10% less energy to operate.
