

Message from our Board Moderator:

We have entered a new church year and I want to thank the congregation for their approval of the 2017-18 church budget at our June 26th business meeting. Also, I would thank Buddy Renaker and the Finance Committee for developing the budget and Karen Adams for her many years of service as our moderator. More than she planned I'm sure.

In mid-May, many of you participated in an online survey as part of a church expansion feasibility study. In fact, 114 of the 175 church giving units participated. The results were very positive, and we have learned that:

--95% of survey respondents agreed or strongly agreed that the "Cynthiana Christian Church effectively meets and supports my spiritual needs."

--95% of survey respondents agreed or strongly agreed that the "Cynthiana Christian Church provides me with opportunities for fellowship and community."

--96% of survey respondents agreed or strongly agreed that they "believe in and trust the leadership of the church to make decisions for the future of our congregation."

--85% of survey respondents agreed or strongly agreed "that the church's financial situation is healthy and secure."

--83% of survey respondents agreed or strongly agreed that "if Cynthiana Christian Church conducted a fundraising capital campaign to complete" an identified expansion project "the membership of the congregation would be supportive of the campaign."

Church extension office advisers from Indianapolis have been encouraged by the level of response to the survey and have confirmed estimated giving to be within range to support a church expansion. This has led Church leadership, which includes the board, trustees, and key committee chairs to recommend a congregational vote to enter into a three-year capital campaign in giving toward our church expansion. This will take place on August 6th at the 10:45 worship service.
