Minister’s Message:

It was good to be back with you yesterday. Your warm welcome was very meaningful and much appreciated. Our sermon yesterday had to do with the imprisonment of the Apostle Paul in the city of Rome. Paul is such an important figure in the history of the church. We know a few details about his life, but I believe there are many more facts we can share regarding his missionary exploits. With this in mind, I have decided to begin a new sermon series with you. It will begin this Sunday and will be entitled, “On the Road Again with Paul.” Here are the specific sermon titles that will be addressed during the series:

- July 31st: “On the Road Again with Paul...At Thessalonica”
- August 7th: “On the Road Again with Paul...At Galatia”
- August 14th: “On the Road Again with Paul...At Corinth”
- August 21st: “On the Road Again with Paul...At Rome”
- August 28th: “On the Road Again with Paul...To Philemon”
- September 4th: “On the Road Again with Paul...At Colossae”
- September 11th: “On the Road Again with Paul...At Ephesus”
- September 18th: “On the Road Again with Paul...At Philippi”

These are being presented in the order of their composition by the Apostle Paul. Specific scriptures for each sermon will follow in the weeks to come.

I also take this time to express my deepest sympathy to the family of one of our most faithful members, Erick “Ricky” Carter. Ricky passed away July 10, 2022 after a very short illness. For years Ricky walked to and from church from Shady Lawn every Sunday. He loved church dinners and would always respond to Brad’s request to stay and eat pizza with the kids on special occasions.
