**Minister's Message:**

This Sunday morning we will address what is a problem with many people, the problem of complaining. The best place to turn in the Bible is the 16<sup>th</sup> chapter of Exodus, where we find the Israelites giving their leader Moses extended moments of stress through their complaining, or whining as we call it. Songwriter Keith Green has written a story about their journey, you might find it relates to many of us:

“And in the morning, it’s manna hotcakes, we snack on manna all day. And They sure had a winner last night for dinner – flaming manna soufflé.”

“Eating leeks and onions by the Nile oohh what breath. Dining out in style. Ooohh my life’s on the skids, give me the pyramids.”

“Give Me the Pyramids” will be the sermon topic for Sunday. Each and every one of us has so much to be thankful for. Grumbling is nothing but forgetfulness. It happened with the Israelites and it happens with us on a day to day basis. Our needed response in life should be one of thanksgiving. The prayer of one Avery Brooke is extremely straightforward.

“I have many things to be thankful for, God. Sometimes I remember them and other times, I forget. When something large or small goes wrong, it fills my mind and I forget those things for which – when I remember – I am thankful. Help me remember the good things, God. To name them, savor them, and to be thankful to you. Amen.”
