In spite of a surprise cold spell, a drought spell, some heavy winds and rains, an aphid plight and some mighty smart raccoons who have sneaked past the electric fence a few times, your church vegetable garden has kept the mighty Garden of Eden volunteers chopping, picking and delivering for over a month.

Even though the aphids destroyed the cucumber plants after they began producing, there was still time to pull up the plants, treat the area and replant. The new plants have come up and are getting ready to provide more cucumbers!

As of July 31, 2016, 409 individual deliveries and 10 large deliveries of one to two bushels of produce have been delivered. And it looks like there will be plenty more going out to remind recipients AND US how much God loves and blesses us in the most common, but also most unusual ways. Be sure to check in Bish Hall every Sunday to see if there is a vegetable or two with which God can remind you how much He loves you...and maybe a neighbor of yours who could use that reminder through produce from Cynthiana Christian Church’s Garden of Eden. Over the past several years I have come to realize that Frank Sinatra is one of my favorite recording artists.
