Minister’s Message:

A favorite book that I read in seminary was a novel by Georges Bernanos, “Diary of a Country Priest.” The book won many literary awards in France, and was later made into an award-winning movie in 1951. Bernanos tells the story of a young priest who struggles with his sense of vocation. His diary reflects his sense of futility about what he has perceived as his call to ministry. And so he frets and frets. We read in his diary, “Am I where the Lord would have me? Twenty times a day I ask this question.” This may be a question we oftentimes ask of ourselves. We may experience daily frustration with some of our efforts in life. But most of us choose to persevere. As students, as workers, as family members, as Christians, we all have to respond to specific calls. This Sunday we will talk about two Old Testament biblical figures who were unlikely candidates for improbable vocations, Moses and Jeremiah. Our sermon topic will be the same question asked by our unnamed country priest in Bernanos’ novel, “Am I Where Our Lord Would Have Me?” If you don’t mind I would like to tell you where I would like to have you on Sunday afternoon, at our all-church picnic at Marie Hehr Park. We have a wonderful afternoon of activities planned, games, outstanding program, vespers, fine-food and fellowship. Gates will open at 4:00 p.m., program to begin at 5:15 p.m., and dinner at 6:00 p.m. Please bring your dish or dishes and come share in this memorable afternoon. We have had some fun moments at the park this summer, and look forward to another one. Invite a friend or someone that perhaps has not been to the park this summer.
