Minister's Message:

Victory Sunday was indeed that. What a time of celebration as you as a congregation fulfilled the goal of our Capital Campaign. More covenant cards are still coming in and we will give you a total as soon as we can. However your response was indeed outstanding and extremely inspirational. To say you are a very special congregation would be an understatement. Last evening our Capital Campaign leaders met with Rhonda Hopewell, representative from the Board of Church Extension to discuss possible financial plans for the project. It was a very worthwhile meeting. Our group is ready to move forward to make this dream become a reality. I was asking Mrs. Hopewell about other Disciple churches in Texas and Florida in regard to damage from recent hurricanes and floods. She suggested the damage in both of those states had been minimal, but Disciple churches in Puerto Rico had not been so fortunate.

I paused and remembered that early in high school, Jordan went with several youth from Kentucky to Puerto Rico for a mission trip. The next year youth from Puerto Rico came to Kentucky. This was a pattern for several years. Jordan certainly had a memorable time on his trip. What I did not remember is that there are over 110 Disciple churches in Puerto Rico. We are aware of what Hurricane Maria has done to Puerto Rico, where power has been knocked out for 3.5 million people. It is not expected to be back in service for three to six months. We also know that over 200 lives were lost in Mexico City in recent weeks due to the earthquake. Just as Week of Compassion is currently in South Texas and Florida, it is also in contact with our partners in Mexico and Puerto Rico. Week of Compassion will be providing assistance in Puerto Rico for recovery efforts in the months and years to follow. Our gifts to Week of Compassion will allow this ministry to remain in these places for the long haul. We usually take up a special offering for the Reconciliation program the last of September. It is my belief we need to use that special offering to once again share our gifts with Week of Compassion. We will take up another Week of Compassion offering this Sunday. Please bring your gifts and your prayers when you come to worship with us Sunday morning.
