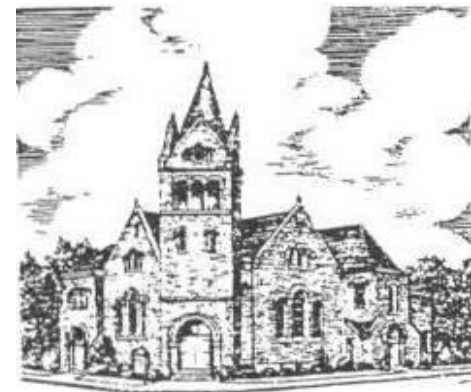

**Minister’s Message:**

This past weekend Anna and I took Noah to see the animated musical adventure *Smallfoot*. It is the story of a community of Yetis who live according to rules literally set into ancient stones. Migo, the star of the movie, one day comes across a plane crash and comes in contact with a human, a “smallfoot.” He tells the village about the discovery, but no one believes him. He is exiled by the stone keeper and eventually goes beneath the clouds and finds the human village below. After many adventures, the community of Yetis meet the humans in the valley. Their fear of one another is replaced by acceptance.

This movie encourages children and adults to question the norm. It may not be true even if a majority of people believe it. It is certainly acceptable to question things that don’t seem right. Migo is brave enough to find out the truth for himself. In discovering the truth, he is able to see things are often more complicated than one might expect. In this movie we see how society can move from being very close – minded, to open to new ideas, and thoughts. This movie has a strong message for people of all ages, especially when it comes to the human tendency to be judgmental. You can read about what Jesus said about receiving all people in Sunday’s scripture, Matthew 25: 31-46. The sermon will be entitled, “Sheep, Goat or Both?” Anna and I will be out of town Monday through Saturday of next week for Blake and Jordan’s birthdays, as well as interment services for Anna’s brother Saturday after next in Virginia. I will be back in the pulpit on October 28<sup>th</sup>. Thanks to all of you for your expressions of grief in our loss.
