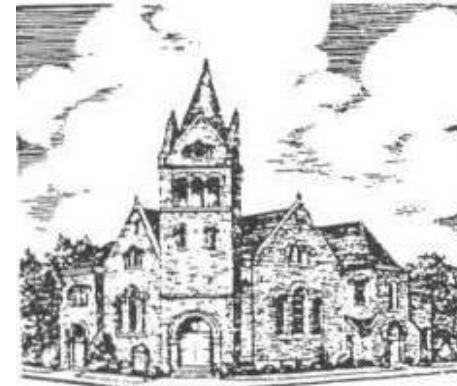

Collection of Plastic Lids and Caps: The Middle School has a goal to collect 2000 pounds of plastic over the next two years. A company in Indiana will melt the plastic to create a picnic table and eight benches for an outdoor classroom. Any plastic lid and any plastic cap are needed. Examples include butternut butter lid, yogurt lid, drink top, milk jug top, condiment lid, aerosol can cap, toothpaste cap and prescription bottle lid. Not accepted are trigger spray tops or “pump” tops as they contain some metal. The only bottle or bottom that is accepted is a prescription bottle: please remove the label that contains personal information. Of course, there is a competition between the Middle School classrooms for the most plastic; therefore, Cynthiana Christian’s Middle School students will rotate turning in our collection. The collection bucket is in the Communion Preparation Room. Remember all plastic bottles, glass bottles and metal cans, including aerosol cans, can be placed in Central Kentucky Hauling’s recycling bin or taken to the dumpster at the County Barn on Connersville Pike. Thank you for being a good steward of God’s creation.
